L 6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
L7	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 11-403.1, is
L8	amended to read as follows:
L 9	Section 11-403.1. A. Any person convicted of failure to yield
20	a right-of-way and who causes a fatality or serious great bodily
21	injury, as defined in Section 11-904 of this title, as a result of
22	such violation may shall, in addition to any other fine or penalty,
23	be assessed a fee in an the amount not exceeding One Thousand
24	Dollars (\$1,000.00) of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to be

- 3 | convicted of failure to yield a right-of-way and who causes a

- B. In addition to the fees provided in subsection A of this

- 3. A payment of restitution of no less than Three Thousand
- 20 Dollars (\$3,000.00), but no more than Ten Thousand Dollars
