13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6224 of Title 36, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	Under any method of compensation, the total commission payable
17	to a public insurance adjuster, including expenses, direct costs, or
18	any other costs accrued by the public insurance adjuster, shall not
19	exceed ten percent (10%) of the amount of the insurance settlement
20	when adjusting for entities subject to The Governmental Tort Claims
21	Act, Section 151 et seq. of Title 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
