14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 353.18B of Title 59, unless
17	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. Pharmacy technician applicants who are seventeen (17) years
19	of age or older and enrolled in a youth apprenticeship program for
20	pharmacy technicians or a pharmacy technician training program
21	through the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education
22	shall complete Phase II pharmacy technician training in a pharmacy
23	without the requirement to be a pharmacy employee. All pharmacy
24	technician training programs shall be approved by the Oklahoma State

1	Board of Pharmacy initially and on an annual basis. This permit
2	will only be used for educational purposes for those enrolled in an
3	Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy approved program.
4	B. The youth apprenticeship program for pharmacy technicians
5	and pharmacy technician training programs through the Oklahoma
6	Department of Career and Technology Education shall carry liability
7	insurance on the students in the respective program that covers the
8	student anywhere the student is training in a pharmacy.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
