An Act relating to civil procedure; amending Section 1439, Chapter 321, O.S.L. 2022 (12 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 1439), which relates to the Oklahoma Citizens Participation Act; excluding certain legal action from act; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 11, Chapter 321, O.S.L. 2022 (12 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 1439), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1439. The Oklahoma Citizens Participation Act shall not apply to:

1. An enforcement action that is brought in the name of this state or a political subdivision of this state by the Attorney General or a district attorney;

2. A legal action brought against a person primarily engaged in the business of selling or leasing goods or services, if the statement or conduct the action is based upon arises out of the sale

1 or lease of goods, services, or an insurance product, insurance
2 services, or a commercial transaction in which the intended audience
3 is an actual or potential buyer or customer;

4 3. A legal action seeking recovery for bodily injury, wrongful
5 death or survival or to statements made regarding that legal action;

6 4. A legal action brought under the Oklahoma Insurance Code or
7 arising out of an insurance contract; or

8 5. A civil action ~~brought under Section 5 of this act~~ arising
9 from an officer-director, employee-employer, or independent
10 contractor relationship that:

11 a. seeks recovery for misappropriation of trade secrets
12 or corporate opportunities, or

13 b. seeks to enforce a non-disparagement agreement,
14 covenant not to compete, non-disclosure agreement, or
15 confidentiality agreement.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
