- 2. Pay the annual groundwater permit fee.
- C. A five-year flex allocation shall allow the permit holder to
 exceed the determined annual allocation in any year of the five-year
 allocation; provided, that the applicant shall adhere to the
 cumulative annually determined allocation of the basin or subbasin
 over the five-year period. The permit holder shall not exceed the
 permitted annual allocation by over two hundred percent (200%) in
 any of the five (5) years.

1	D. Nothing in this section shall apply to domestic wells.
2	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
