NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1000.31 of Title 59, unless 17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 The Department of Human Services shall work with the Oklahoma 19 State Fire Marshal to develop guidelines that allow family child 20 care homes and large child care homes, as defined in Section 402 of 21 Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to operate under the requirements 22 of the 2018 International Residential Code as adopted by the 23 Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission (OUBCC). Family child 24

1	care homes and large child care homes shall not be denied a license
2	to operate should they comply with the requirements of the
3	guidelines as established by the Department and the Oklahoma State
4	Fire Marshal. No agency, municipality, county, or other political
5	subdivision of this state shall place stricter fire and life safety
6	requirements than those outlined in the 2018 International
7	Residential Code as adopted by the OUBCC on family child care homes
8	and large child care homes.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
