16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 50 O.S. 2021, Section 2, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	Section 2. A public nuisance is one which affects at the same
20	time an entire community or neighborhood, or any considerable number
21	of persons, although the extent of the annoyance or damage inflicted
22	upon the individuals may be unequal. The manufacturing, marketing,
23	and selling of lawful products shall not be deemed a public
24	nuisance.

- 1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 50 O.S. 2021, Section 8, is
- 2 | amended to read as follows:
- 3 Section 8. A. The remedies against a public nuisance are:
- 4 1. Indictment or information, or;
- 5 2. A civil action, or seeking injunctive or other equitable

- 8 B. To be found liable in an action for public nuisance, the
- 9 defendant in such an action must be determined by the court to have
- 10 been in control of the conditions giving rise to the nuisance at the
- 11 | time of injury.

- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 Section 10. A private person may maintain an action for a
- 15 | public nuisance if it the court determines by clear and convincing
- 16 | evidence that the nuisance is specially injurious the proximate
- 17 | cause of special injury to himself the private person, but not
- 18 otherwise.
- 19 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 50 O.S. 2021, Section 21, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 Section 21. The repeated use of any real property or structure
- 22 | thereon to commit unlawful drug distribution, prostitution, human
- 23 trafficking, or sex trafficking acts which result in a felony
