B. The State Fire Marshal shall create an application system
for volunteer firefighters to apply for the grant assistance. The
State Fire Marshal may promulgate rules for the grant program.

8 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 342.24 of Title 74, unless there 10 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund 11 12 for the State Fire Marshal to be designated the "Oklahoma Volunteer Firefighter Support Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing 13 fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of 14 all monies received by the State Fire Marshal from appropriations, 15 donations, grants, or other sources of funding specifically 16 designated for deposit to the Oklahoma Volunteer Firefighter Support 17 Revolving Fund. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are 18 hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State 19 Fire Marshal for the purpose of this act. Expenditures from said 20 fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer 21 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the 22 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and 23 24 payment.
