A. The Oklahoma Legislature recognizes that 17 public school paraprofessionals play an important role in educating 18 school children and in assisting teachers. The Legislature further 19 recognizes the increasing role of public school paraprofessionals in 20 the school system in light of teacher shortages. To achieve the 21 goal of excellence for all persons who have an impact on student 22 learning, it is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that public 23

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school paraprofessionals be afforded career opportunities and economic incentives through a career development program.

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- The State Board of Education shall adopt a program for the 3 В. career development of public school paraprofessionals. The purpose 4 5 of the program is to provide to public school paraprofessionals a system of career development which is based upon education and 6 training advancement to encourage excellence among public school 7 paraprofessionals. Public school paraprofessionals who hold a 8 9 bachelor's degree in education or education studies and who have not 10 been out of the classroom for more than ten (10) years shall be 11 deemed to have satisfied any rule that requires additional 12 professional education coursework from an institution of higher education under the adopted program. Nothing in this section shall 13 be construed to require public school paraprofessionals to 14 participate in the career development program. 15
 - C. The board of education of a school district shall have authority to extend an existing contract with a public school paraprofessional that provides for the payment of compensation for paraprofessional services rendered for the same time period during which the paraprofessional is also assigned to the school district for practice teaching as a student teacher.
 - D. For the purposes of this section, a public school paraprofessional is an employee of a school district whose position is either instructional in nature, or who delivers other direct

- 6 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
- 7 | in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-213 of Title 70, unless there
- 8 | is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- 9 Teachers who hold a bachelor's degree in education or education
- 10 studies shall be deemed to have satisfied any State Board of
- 11 | Education rule that requires teachers to complete additional
- 12 | professional education coursework from an institution of higher
- 13 | education as a condition to obtain, renew, or satisfy any other
- 14 | professional development requirement for an emergency certificate,
- 15 alternate placement teaching certificate, or standard certificate if
- 16 the teacher has not been out of the classroom for more than ten (10)
- 17 years.
- 18 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.
- 19 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
- 20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
- 21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
- 22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
