13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 858-359, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 858-359. A. The payment or promise of payment or
17	compensation by a party to a broker does not determine what
18	relationship, if any, has been established between the broker and a
19	party to a transaction.
20	B. In the event a broker receives a fee or compensation from
21	any party to the transaction based on a selling price or lease cost
22	of a transaction, such receipt does not constitute a breach of duty
23	or obligation to any party to the transaction.

1	C. A broker or real estate owner of record may compensate or
2	offer compensation to any real estate professional licensed by the
3	Oklahoma Real Estate Commission for providing brokerage services in
4	connection with the purchase, lease, sale, transfer, or exchange of
5	real estate located in this state.
6	${ t D.}$ ${ t 1.}$ Nothing in this section requires a broker to charge, or
7	prohibits a broker from charging, a separate fee or other
8	compensation for each duty or other brokerage services provided
9	during a transaction.
10	2. Nothing in this section requires a broker or real estate
11	owner of record to offer compensation to any real estate
12	professional in this state.
13	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
