SENATE BILL NO. 1226

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2021, Sections 10-103 and 10-106, which relate to accidents; expanding criteria by which a person must remain at scene or make notification of certain accident; making language gender neutral; updating statutory language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 10-103, is

amended to read as follows:

Section 10-103. The driver of any a vehicle involved in an accident resulting only in damage to property or a vehicle which is driven or attended by any person shall immediately stop such vehicle at the scene of such the accident or as close thereto to the scene of the accident as possible but or shall forthwith immediately return to and in every event the scene of the accident. The driver shall remain at the scene of such the accident until he or she has fulfilled the requirements of Section 10-104 of this title. Every stop shall be made without obstructing traffic more than is

1 necessary. Any person failing to stop or comply with said the
2 requirements under such circumstances of this section shall, upon
3 conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof
4 shall be punished punishable by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred
5 Dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for not
6 more than one (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment. In
7 addition to the criminal penalties imposed by this section, any
8 person violating the provisions of this section shall be subject to
9 liability for damages in an amount equal to three times the value of
10 the damage caused by the accident. Said Such damages shall be
11 recoverable in a civil action. Nothing in this section shall
12 prevent a judge from ordering restitution for any damage caused by a
13 driver involved in an accident provided for in this section.

14 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 10-106, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 10-106. The driver of any vehicle involved in an
17 accident resulting only in damage to fixtures, fences, or other
18 property legally upon or adjacent to a public or private road,
19 street, or highway shall take reasonable steps to locate and notify
20 the owner or person in charge of such property of such fact and of
21 the driver's name and address and of the registration number of the
22 vehicle being driven and shall upon request exhibit a driver license
23 and security verification form, as defined in Section 7-600 of this

1 title, and shall make report of such accident when and as required
2 in Section 10-108 of this title.

3 Any person failing to stop or comply with ~~said~~ such requirements
4 under such circumstances shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a
5 misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars
6 (\$500.00) l or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than
7 one (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Nothing in
8 this section shall prevent a judge from ordering restitution for any
9 damage caused by a driver involved in an accident provided for in
10 this section.

11 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
