9	Act; amending 57 O.S. 2021, Section 582, as amended by Section 14, Chapter 151, O.S.L. 2024 (57 O.S.
10	Supp. 2024, Section 582), which relates to persons and crimes to which act applies; prohibiting certain
11	agreement; prohibiting removal of certain requirement; prohibiting contact with any minor;
12	updating statutory language and reference; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2021, Section 582, as
17	amended by Section 14, Chapter 151, O.S.L. 2024 (57 O.S. Supp. 2024,
18	Section 582), is amended to read as follows:
19	Section 582. A. The provisions of the Sex Offenders
20	Registration Act shall apply to any person residing, working, or
21	attending school within the State of Oklahoma <u>this state</u> who, after
22	November 1, 1989, has been convicted, whether upon a verdict or plea
23	of guilty or upon a plea of nolo contendere, or received a suspended

sentence or any probationary term, or is currently serving a

sentence or any form of probation or parole for a crime or an attempt to commit a crime provided for in Section 843.5 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation as those terms are defined in Section 1-1-105 of Title 10A of the Oklahoma Statutes, Section 681, if the offense involved sexual assault, 741, if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation, Section 748, if the offense involved human trafficking for commercial sex, Section 843.1, if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation, Section 852.1, if the offense involved sexual abuse of a child, 856, if the offense involved child sex trafficking or human trafficking for commercial sex, 865 et seq., 885, 886, 888, 891, if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation, 1021, 1021.2, 1021.3, 1024.2, 1029, if the offense involved child sex trafficking, 1040.8, if the offense involved child pornography sexual abuse material, 1040.12a, 1040.13, 1040.13a, 1087, 1088, 1111.1, 1114, or 1123 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

B. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall apply to any person who after November 1, 1989, resides, works, or attends school within the State of Oklahoma this state and who has been convicted or received a suspended sentence at any time in any court of another state, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the Northern Mariana Islands and the United States Virgin Islands, a federal court, an Indian tribal court, a military

- court, or a court of a foreign country for a crime, attempted crime,

 or a conspiracy to commit a crime which, if committed or attempted

 in this state, would be a crime, an attempt to commit a crime, or a

 conspiracy to commit a crime provided for in any of the laws listed

 in subsection A of this section.
- C. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall 6 apply to any person who resides, works, or attends school within the 7 State of Oklahoma this state and who has received a deferred 9 judgment at any time in any court of another state, the District of 10 Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the Northern Mariana Islands and the United States Virgin Islands, a federal court, an 11 12 Indian tribal court, a military court, or a court of a foreign country for a crime, attempted crime, or a conspiracy to commit a 13 crime which, if committed or attempted or conspired to be committed 14 in this state, would be a crime, an attempt to commit a crime, or a 15 conspiracy to commit a crime provided for in Section 843.5 of Title 16 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes if the offense involved sexual abuse or 17 sexual exploitation as those terms are defined in Section 1-1-105 of 18 Title 10A of the Oklahoma Statutes, Section 681, if the offense 19 involved sexual assault, 741, if the offense involved sexual abuse 20 or sexual exploitation, Section 748, if the offense involved human 21 trafficking for commercial sex, Section 843.1, if the offense 22 involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation, Section 852.1, if the 23 offense involved sexual abuse of a child, 856, if the offense 24

1 involved child sex trafficking or human trafficking for commercial sex, 865 et seq., 885, 886, 888, 891, if the offense involved sexual 2 abuse or sexual exploitation, 1021, 1021.2, 1021.3, 1024.2, 1029, if 3 the offense involved child sex trafficking, 1040.8, if the offense 5 involved child pornography sexual abuse material, 1040.12a, 1040.13, 1040.13a, 1087, 1088, 1111.1, 1114, or 1123 of Title 21 of the 6 Oklahoma Statutes. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration 7 Act shall not apply to any such person while the person is 9 incarcerated in a maximum or medium correctional institution of the Department of Corrections. 10

- D. On November 1, 2002, any person registered as a sex offender pursuant to Section 741 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be summarily removed from the Sex Offender Registry sex offender registry by the Department of Corrections and all law enforcement agencies of any political subdivision of this state, unless the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation.
- E. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall not apply to any such person who has received a criminal history records expungement for a conviction in another state for a crime or attempted crime which, if committed or attempted in this state, would be a crime or an attempt to commit a crime provided for in any laws listed in subsection A of this section.
- F. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall apply to any person residing, working, or attending school within

- this state who, after the effective date of this act November 1,

 2 2020, has been convicted, whether upon a verdict or plea of guilty

 3 or upon a plea of nolo contendere, or received a suspended sentence

 4 or any probationary term, or is currently serving a sentence or any

 5 form of probation or parole for a crime or an attempt to commit a

 6 crime as provided for in subsection G of Section 1040.13b of Title

 7 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
 - G. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall apply to any person who resides, works, or attends school within this state and who has received a deferred judgment at any time in any court of another state, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the Northern Mariana Islands and the United States Virgin Islands, a federal court, an Indian tribal court, a military court, or a court of a foreign country for a crime, if committed in this state, would be a crime, as provided for in subsection F of Section 1040.13b of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall not apply to any such person while the person is incarcerated in a maximum or medium correctional institution in the custody of the Department of Corrections.
 - H. Any person who has been convicted, whether upon a verdict or plea of guilty or upon a plea of nolo contendere, or received a suspended sentence or any probationary term or parole for a crime which requires the person to register as a sex offender pursuant to

1	the terms of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall not enter into
2	a plea agreement whereby the offender shall be allowed to forgo
3	registering as a sex offender.
4	I. The sealing of a criminal record or other action that limits
5	the publicity or availability of conviction information shall not
6	remove the requirement of an individual to register as a sex
7	offender pursuant to the provisions of the Sex Offenders
8	Registration Act.
9	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 590.3 of Title 57, unless there
11	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
12	Any person who is required to register under the provisions of
13	the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall not be allowed to have any
14	contact with a person under eighteen (18) years of age, including
15	the child of such person.
16	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
