| 15 | SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be   |

garages, and any associated grounds, buildings, or appurtenances used to operate the races.

B. No action for nuisance shall be brought against a racing facility by an owner of real property within a three-mile radius of the racing facility if the developer of the facility obtained all permits required for construction, and established a vested right in the development of the property or contiguous group of properties where the racing facility is located, prior to the date of the owner purchasing real property or constructing any building within the three-mile radius of the racing facility. Provided, however, such liability protection shall not apply if the racing facility fails to operate in substantial compliance with federal, state, and local laws and regulations applicable to activities occurring at the facility.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
