AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 281, O.S.L. 16 2023, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 408, O.S.L. 2024 (70 O.S. 17 Supp. 2025, Section 5-148.2), is amended to read as follows: 18 Section 5-148.2. A. There is hereby created in the State 19 Treasury a revolving fund for the State Department of Education to 20 be designated the "School Security Revolving Fund". The fund shall 21 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and 22 shall consist of all monies received by the State Department of 23 Education from:

- 4. Monies appropriated or apportioned by the Legislature.
- B. All monies accruing to the credit of the School Security
  Revolving Fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and
  expended by the State Department of Education for the purposes of:
- Establishing and maintaining a School Resource Officer
   Program; and
- 2. Providing physical security enhancements for schools including, but not limited to, school resource officers, cameras, gates, lighting, locks, doors, windows, security geofencing, ballistic storm shelters, and mobile panic alert systems; and
- 3. Contracting with a licensed mental health professional to provide counseling and social services to students.

Monies in the School Security Revolving Fund shall supplement and not supplant existing school security funding.

C. Expenditures from the School Security Revolving Fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

Expenditures from the School Security Revolving Fund shall not
