- 5. Any district attorney whose salary is governed by Section 215.30 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 6. Employees of institutions under the administrative authority of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education;
- 7. Persons employed pursuant to Section 2241 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 8. Persons employed pursuant to Section 1.6a of Title 53 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 9. Persons who are employed or under contract pursuant to subsection B of Section 1419 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and
- 10. The Adjutant General and Assistant Adjutants General pursuant to Section 27 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- E. No salary increase pursuant to this section shall be made that exceeds a salary limitation provided in an agency's annual appropriation bill or salary limits set by statute.
- F. With respect to any employee who is not a full-time employee, the salary increase amounts otherwise authorized by subsection A of this section shall be prorated using a methodology applicable to the employee's compensation, weeks worked, months worked, hours worked, or a similar method.
  - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2026.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and	
2	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
