2nd Session of the 60th Legislature (2026) By: Nice AS INTRODUCED An Act relating to the Domestic Violence Fatality Review Board; creating the Domestic Violence Fatality Review Board Revolving Fund; stating purpose of fund; making an appropriation; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1604 of Title 22, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Office of the Attorney General to be designated the "Domestic Violence Fatality Review Board Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received from legislative appropriations. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are 22 hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Office 23 of the Attorney General for the purposes provided in subsection B of 24 this section. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon

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warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

B. The purpose of the fund is to develop a state and local database on domestic violence deaths pursuant to paragraph 3 of subsection A of Section 1601 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

Such database shall be developed and implemented within twenty-four (24) months of the effective date of this act.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Domestic Violence Fatality Review Board Revolving Fund from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2027, the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Attorney General by law.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2026.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
