SENATE BILL 1316

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to administrative rules; directing permanent rules of certain agencies to sunset on certain dates; requiring certain agencies, boards, or commissions to submit their permanent rules to the Legislature for review by certain dates; directing review to be conducted in accordance with certain act; allowing renewal of certain rules for certain time period; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 250.11 of Title 75, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. On February 1, 2027, and on February 1 every four (4) years thereafter, the permanent rules promulgated by or on behalf of the following agencies, boards, or commissions shall sunset, and the following agencies, boards, or commissions shall submit to the Legislature their permanent rules adopted pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act for review:

1. The Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission;

2. The Oklahoma Abstractors Board;
3. The Oklahoma Accountancy Board;
4. The Board of Governors of the Architects, Landscape Architects and Licensed Interior Designers of Oklahoma;
5. The Office of the State Auditor and Inspector;
6. The Banking Board;
7. The Construction Industries Board;
8. The Department of Consumer Credit;
9. The State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering;
10. The Oklahoma Employment Security Commission;
11. The State Fire Marshal;
12. The Department of Labor;
13. The Oklahoma Lottery Commission;
14. The Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority;
15. The Oklahoma Real Estate Commission;
16. The Real Estate Appraiser Board;
17. The Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission;

5 E. Permanent rules submitted to the Legislature pursuant to the
6 provisions of this section:

7 1. Shall be subject to the review, approval, and disapproval
8 provisions provided for in Section 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma
9 Statutes; and

10 2. May be renewed for additional terms of four (4) years, or
11 fewer, by the Legislature by approval and enactment of a joint
12 resolution.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.

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
