AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the State Department of Education; creating the Career Counselor Revolving Fund; specifying sources of fund; providing for expenditures; providing purpose of fund; making an appropriation; providing for codification; providing for noncodification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-104.12 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the State Department of Education to be designated the "Career Counselor Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Department from appropriations, gifts, grants, donations, and bequests provided for the purpose of providing support for career counselors in school districts in this state.

All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby

appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department for the purpose provided for in this subsection. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment. SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be

codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

There is hereby appropriated to the Career Counselor Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 1 of this act from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2027, the sum of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Department of Education by law.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2026.

It being immediately necessary for the preservation SECTION 4. of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
