The State Board of Career and Technology 21 Education shall promulgate rules for the distribution of the funds. 22 B. Subject to the availability of funding, the Legislature 23 shall provide matching funds for federal grant funds received by the 24 state through the Adult Education and Family Literacy Act provided

by the United States Department of Education, or any successor grant program of the same purpose administered by any agency of the United States, on a dollar-for-dollar basis. In the event that federal grant funding for the Adult Education and Family Literacy Act is discontinued and no successor program is designated, the Legislature shall continue the program at a rate equal to twice the last full year of federal grant funds received from the program, subject to the availability of funding. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2026. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
