6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to blood donation; requiring blood  
8 service systems to comply with certain physician  
9 orders; authorizing certain fee; requiring hospitals  
to allow certain blood donations; providing for  
codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2167.2 of Title 63, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. A blood service system shall comply with a physician's order  
17 prescribing for an individual an autologous or direct blood  
18 donation.

19 B. A blood service system may charge a fee in an amount  
20 reasonable and necessary to cover the administrative cost to the  
21 blood service system of facilitating an autologous or direct blood  
22 donation ordered by a physician under subsection A of this section.

23 C. A hospital licensed by the State Department of Health that  
24 facilitates blood donations shall allow an individual on whom a

1 medical procedure is to be performed to provide an autologous or  
2 direct blood donation a physician orders for the procedure.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
