SENATE BILL 1665

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to firearms; prohibiting courts from abridging a person's right to possess a firearm; requiring return of seized firearms; providing an exception; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1290.28 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A court shall not abridge a person's right to purchase, possess, concealed carry, or open carry a firearm in this state. No court shall require a firearm seized due to a misdemeanor arrest or conviction to be forfeited or destroyed. Seized firearms shall be returned after a misdemeanor case is resolved, unless the firearm was used during the commission of the misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
