7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act;
8 amending 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1290.6, which relates
9 to prohibited ammunition; modifying scope of certain
unlawful act; removing administrative penalty; and
providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1290.6, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1290.6.

16 PROHIBITED AMMUNITION

17 Any concealed or unconcealed handgun when carried in a manner
18 authorized by the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act and
19 when loaded with any ammunition which is ~~either~~ a restricted bullet
20 as defined by Section 1289.19 of this title ~~or is larger than .45~~
21 ~~caliber~~ or is otherwise prohibited by law shall be deemed a
22 prohibited weapon for purposes of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act.
23 Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be
24 punished for a criminal offense as provided by Section 1272 of this

1 title or any other applicable provision of law. In addition to any
2 ~~criminal prosecution for a violation of the provisions of this~~
3 ~~section, the licensee shall be subject to an administrative fine of~~
4 ~~Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), upon a hearing and determination by~~
5 ~~the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation that the person is in~~
6 ~~violation of the provisions of this section.~~

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
