SENATE BILL 1700

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to purchasing; directing the Purchasing Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to create certain portal; requiring state agencies to submit certain record to Division; providing for the publication of certain record on certain portal; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.48 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. On or before January 1, 2027, the Purchasing Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall create and maintain on its website a State Purchasing Portal. Such portal shall allow the public to view a record of purchases made by state agencies, entities, and instrumentalities.

B. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a state agency, entity, or instrumentality shall, within thirty (30) days after completing any purchase utilizing appropriated state funds,

1 electronically submit a record of such purchase to the Purchasing  
2 Division, including any receipts associated with such purchase.

3 2. The Purchasing Division shall, within thirty (30) days after  
4 receiving such submission from a state agency, entity, or  
5 instrumentality, publish the record of the purchase, including any  
6 receipts associated with such purchase, on the State Purchasing  
7 Portal.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
