AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to municipalities; subjecting campsites on municipal land to certain review by the Department of Environmental Quality and the Department of Public Safety; providing for the promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 43-117 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Any campsite on land within a municipality shall be subject to evaluation by the Department of Environmental Quality and the Department of Public Safety if such campsite has been utilized by ten or more individuals for more than five (5) days. Such evaluation shall be based on basic environmental and sanitation standards.

B. The Department of Environmental Quality and the Department of Public Safety shall promulgate rules to effectuate the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
