L 6	Section 5025. <u>A.</u> The Oklahoma Health Care Authority may
L7	establish, with available funds, a reimbursement methodology that
L8	will enhance the reimbursement for services provided to Medicaid
L 9	beneficiaries in emergency hospitals in rural areas of the state.
20	B. The Authority shall establish, with available funds, a
21	reimbursement methodology for the state Medicaid program that
22	reimburses for obstetrical care at hospitals designated as Baby-
23	Friendly by Baby-Friendly USA at a rate equal to the product of the

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standard reimbursement rate for obstetrical care at hospitals

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    multiplied by a factor of one and one quarter (1 \ 1/4). The
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    Authority shall seek any federal approval necessary to implement the
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    provisions of this subsection.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.
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        SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
