19	heartland of America, rose from humble beginnings to become a
20	towering figure in the defense of liberty, embodying the indomitable
21	spirit of the First Amendment through his tireless advocacy for oper

23	WHEREAS, as the founder and chief executive officer of Turning
24	Point USA, Kirk ignited a movement that empowered a generation of
25	young Americans, particularly on college campuses, to engage in
26	robust, fearless debate free from the shadows of censorship and

- 8 beliefs amid a culture often hostile to conviction; and
- 9 WHEREAS, on September 10, 2025, Charlie Kirk was tragically
- 10 martyred by assassination, a cowardly act that sought to extinguish
- 11 his voice but instead amplified his eternal message of resilience,
- 12 reminding us that the cost of courage can be great, yet the light of
- 13 truth endures beyond the grave; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Kirk's martyrdom underscores his unparalleled courage
- 15 and fearless willingness to confront power, challenge orthodoxy, and
- 16 sacrifice his life for the greater good of American liberty, proving
- 17 that true heroism lies in defending the vulnerable ideas that
- 18 sustain our constitutional republic; and
- 19 WHEREAS, in this moment of profound loss, the State of Oklahoma
- 20 recognizes the sacred duty to honor Kirk's legacy by fostering
- 21 environments where his values of faith, truth, and free expression
- 22 can flourish, ensuring that his martyrdom is not in vain but a
- 23 catalyst for renewed commitment to intellectual and spiritual
