HOUSE BILL 3056

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to milk; amending 2 O.S. 2021, Section 7-414, which relates to the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Acts; providing additional acts that are not prohibited; removing gallon limit for incidental sale of raw milk; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2021, Section 7-414, is amended to read as follows:

Section 7-414. ~~A.~~ The provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act shall not be construed to:

1. Include ~~incidental~~ sales of raw, unpasteurized cow milk, goat milk, sheep milk, donkey milk, and horse milk directly to consumers at:

a. the farm where the milk is produced,

b. feed stores,

c. restaurants,

d. at a farmer's market, or

1           e.   via delivery from the farm where the milk is produced;

2           2.   ~~Preclude~~ Prohibit the advertising of the ~~incidental~~ sale of  
3   raw, unpasteurized cow milk, goat milk, sheep milk, donkey milk, and  
4   horse milk; and or

5           3.   Prohibit any farmer or producer from making cheese using  
6   milk or cream produced on the farm of such farmer or producer.

7           ~~B. For purposes of this section, incidental sales of goat milk~~  
8   ~~are those sales where the average monthly number of gallons sold~~  
9   ~~does not exceed one hundred (100).~~

10          SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
