AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to firearms; amending 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1290.6, which relates to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act; deleting prohibition on certain type of ammunition; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1290.6, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1290.6.

PROHIBITED AMMUNITION

Any concealed or unconcealed handgun when carried in a manner authorized by the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act and when loaded with any ammunition which is either a restricted bullet as defined by Section 1289.19 of this title or is ~~larger than .45~~ ~~caliber or is~~ otherwise prohibited by law shall be deemed a prohibited weapon for purposes of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act.

Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be

1 punished for a criminal offense as provided by Section 1272 of this
2 title or any other applicable provision of law. In addition to any
3 criminal prosecution for a violation of the provisions of this
4 section, the licensee shall be subject to an administrative fine of
5 Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), upon a hearing and determination by
6 the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation that the person is in
7 violation of the provisions of this section.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
