6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to district attorneys; directing  
8 district attorneys to submit certain quarterly  
9 report; requiring submission of quarterly report to  
10 certain entities; directing the District Attorneys  
11 Council to submit annual report with aggregated data;  
12 authorizing the District Attorneys Council to issue  
13 standardized reporting requirements; providing for  
14 codification; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 215.42 of Title 19, unless there  
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Upon the effective date of this act, the district attorney  
19 for each district court judicial district shall provide a quarterly  
20 report with the number of cases submitted or referred to the  
21 district attorney by state agencies serving children and juveniles  
22 including the Oklahoma Department of Human Services and the Office  
23 of Juvenile Affairs, that the district attorney declined to file  
24 charges and prosecute, to the Legislature, the Office of Management

1 and Enterprise Services, and the appropriate standing committee of  
2 the respective body having oversight of the District Attorneys  
3 Council.

4       B. The District Attorneys Council shall prepare an annual  
5 comprehensive statistical report based upon the data gathered from  
6 each district attorney that shall include the types of referrals and  
7 stated reason for non-prosecution, when available. The annual  
8 report shall be submitted to the Legislature, the Office of  
9 Management and Enterprise Services, and the appropriate standing  
10 committee of the respective body having oversight of the District  
11 Attorneys Council.

12       C. The District Attorneys Council shall be authorized to issue  
13 standardized reporting requirements to ensure compliance with the  
14 provisions of this section.

15       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
