HOUSE BILL 3390

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Home and Community Based programs; directing the Oklahoma Department of Human Services to update and maintain a certain website; requiring the Department to include a rating system, inspection reports, substantiated complaints, and administrator information; mandating annual updates from agencies; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1975 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Department of Human Services shall update and maintain its Provider Search website that locates agencies that provide services for the following Home and Community Based programs:

1. Advantage Waiver;
2. Living Choice;
3. Medically Fragile Waiver; and

1 4. State Plan Personal Care (SPPC).

2 B. The website shall also include:

3 1. A rating system established by the Department or another
4 accredited licensing agency;

5 2. Inspection reports;

6 3. Substantiated complaints;

7 4. Administrator information; and

8 5. A form to be able to report an issue with an agency.

9 C. The Department shall require agencies to update information
10 on the website annually.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.

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
