HOUSE BILL 3435

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to cities and towns; requiring municipal bond proposals to contain one subject and express subject in ballot title; clarifying that multiple proposals shall be permitted; providing test to determine whether proposal violates act; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 13-113 of Title 26, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Every municipal bond proposal to be voted on by the citizens of that municipality shall contain only one subject and the subject shall be expressed and defined in its ballot title.

B. Multiple bond proposals shall be permitted to be on the same ballot, provided they require separate votes to be cast.

C. A bond proposal may violate this act if the monies raised through the bond are appropriated and spent by more than a single agency, department, or director within the municipality.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
