HOUSE BILL 4106

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 2021, Sections 1704 and 1706, which relate to grand and petit larceny; decreasing threshold amount for grand larceny offenses; providing felony penalty for third and subsequent petit larceny convictions; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1704, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1704. Grand larceny is larceny committed in either of the following cases:

1. When the property taken is of a value of ~~One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00)~~ Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or greater; or

2. When such property, although not of a value of ~~One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00)~~ Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or greater, is taken from the person of another.

Larceny in other cases is petit larceny.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1706, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1706. A. Petit larceny shall be punishable by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) or more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or imprisonment in the county jail not to six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court.

B. Any person convicted of a third or subsequent offense of petit larceny shall be guilty of a felony, punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not exceeding two (2) years, or a fine not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.

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
