HOUSE JOINT
RESOLUTION 1067

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article XXV-A of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma; allowing the State of Oklahoma not cover Medicaid expansion if federal financial participation drops below ninety-percent matching; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
2ND SESSION OF THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article XXV-A of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

A. In addition to those otherwise eligible for medical assistance under Oklahoma's Medicaid program, the State shall provide medical assistance under Oklahoma's Medicaid program to Low Income Adults.

1 B. No greater or additional burdens or restrictions on
2 eligibility or enrollment shall be imposed on persons eligible for
3 medical assistance pursuant to this Article than on any other
4 population eligible for medical assistance under Oklahoma's Medicaid
5 program.

6 C. If the federal financial participation is less than ninety
7 percent (90%) for Medicaid expansion, the Oklahoma Legislature may
8 decide to not cover the additional costs to the state.

9 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
10 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
11 the following form:

14 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

15 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. The measure
16 amends Section 2 of Article 25A by allowing the State of
17 Oklahoma to not cover the Medicaid expansion if the federal
18 financial participation drops below ninety percent (90%)
19 matching.
