6 AS INTRODUCED

7

8 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
9 to refer to the people for their approval or
10 rejection a proposed amendment to Section 3 of
11 Article VI of the Constitution of the State of
12 Oklahoma; requiring a person to be an attorney
13 licensed to practice law in the State of Oklahoma who
14 has been practicing law for at least ten (10) years
15 to be eligible for the office of Attorney General;
16 providing ballot title; and directing filing.

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
18 2ND SESSION OF THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

19 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
20 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
21 the following proposed amendment to Section 3 of Article VI of the
22 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

23 Section 3. A. No person shall be eligible to the office of
24 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, State Auditor and
Inspector, Attorney General, State Treasurer, or Superintendent of
Public Instruction except a citizen of the United States of the age
of not less than thirty-one (31) years and who shall have been ten

1 (10) years next preceding his or her election, or appointment, a
2 qualified elector of this state.

3 B. In addition to the eligibility requirements in subsection A
4 of this section, no person shall be eligible to the office of
5 Attorney General except an attorney licensed to practice law in the
6 State of Oklahoma who has been practicing law for at least ten (10)
7 years.

8 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
9 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
10 the following form:

13 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

14 This proposition amends Section 3 of Article 6 of the Oklahoma
15 Constitution. Section 3 provides the eligibility requirements
16 for certain state offices including the office of Attorney
17 General. This proposition would amend the section to also
18 require that for a person to be eligible to be Attorney General
19 the person must be an attorney licensed to practice law in the
20 State of Oklahoma who has been practicing law for at least ten
21 (10) years.
