HOUSE JOINT  
RESOLUTION 1074

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma by adding a new section to Article X to be designated as Section 44; creating the Oklahoma Veterans Lottery Trust Fund; providing for funding source; requiring funds to be expended only for veteran-related purposes; designating funds to be administered by the Oklahoma Veterans Trust Fund Board of Governors; providing for membership; prohibiting Legislature from using funds to supplant other funding; directing the State Board of Equalization to examine and investigate appropriations annually; requiring appropriation if certain funds are determined to have been supplanted; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma by adding a new Section 44 to Article X thereof, to read as follows:

1       A. There is hereby created a trust fund to be known as the  
2 "Oklahoma Veterans Lottery Trust Fund". The trust fund shall  
3 consist of funds transferred to it from the Oklahoma Veterans  
4 Lottery game.

5       B. Monies in the Oklahoma Veterans Lottery Trust Fund shall  
6 only be expended for the following purposes:

7       1. Grants to congressionally-chartered veterans service  
8 organizations within the state for operational funding related to  
9 youth education programs, assisting veterans in need, and providing  
10 service officer funding;

11       2. Grants to individual veterans registered with the Oklahoma  
12 Veterans Registry, widows or widowers of veterans, or family members  
13 designated as a caretaker by the Department of Veterans Affairs for  
14 use during catastrophic emergencies;

15       3. Grants for funding indigent veteran funerals when all other  
16 means of funding have been attempted or exhausted; and

17       4. Grants for veteran outreach programs where veteran  
18 attendance is greater than fifty percent (50%) of the total  
19 attendance to supplement funding needed for operational costs  
20 directly related to the programs.

21       C. Funds deposited in the Oklahoma Veterans Lottery Trust Fund  
22 shall be administered by the Oklahoma Veterans Trust Fund Board of  
23 Governors. The Board of Governors shall consist of nine (9)  
24 members, one member from each of the following veteran service

1 organizations: Disabled American Veterans, American Legion,  
2 Veterans of Foreign Wars, Paralyzed Veterans of America, National  
3 Guard, Air National Guard, Military Order of the Purple Heart, the  
4 Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and two additional members  
5 appointed by the Oklahoma Veterans Council. Chartered organizations  
6 in good standing with the Secretary of State of Oklahoma shall  
7 appoint their members and an alternate to the Board of Governors for  
8 a term of two (2) years. No member shall serve more than three  
9 terms.

10 D. The Legislature shall appropriate funds from the Oklahoma  
11 Veterans Lottery Trust Fund only for the purposes specified in  
12 subsection B of this section. The Legislature shall not use funds  
13 from the Oklahoma Veterans Lottery Trust Fund to supplant or replace  
14 other state funds supporting the military, veterans, or their  
15 families.

16 E. In order to ensure that the funds from the trust fund are  
17 used to enhance and not supplant funding for the military, veterans  
18 or their families, the State Board of Equalization shall examine and  
19 investigate appropriations from the Oklahoma Veterans Lottery Trust  
20 Fund each year. At the meeting of the State Board of Equalization  
21 held within five (5) days after the monthly apportionment in  
22 February of each year, the State Board of Equalization shall issue a  
23 finding and report, which shall state whether appropriations from  
24 the trust fund were used to enhance or supplant military, veteran,

1 or their families' funding. If the State Board of Equalization  
2 finds that funding for military, veterans, or their families was  
3 supplanted by the funds from the Oklahoma Veterans Lottery Trust  
4 Fund, the State Board of Equalization shall specify the amount of  
5 funding that was supplanted. If funding is found to have been  
6 supplanted, the Legislature shall not make any appropriations for  
7 the ensuing fiscal year until an appropriation in the supplanted  
8 fund amount is made to replenish the Oklahoma Veterans Lottery Trust  
9 Fund.

10 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional  
11 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in  
12 the following form:

15 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

16 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It adds a  
17 new Section 44 to Article 10. This measure would create the  
18 Oklahoma Veterans Lottery Trust Fund. The trust fund shall  
19 consist of monies from the Oklahoma Veterans Lottery game.  
20 The monies of the trust fund shall only be used for certain  
21 veteran-related purposes. Trust funds shall be administered  
22 by the Oklahoma Veterans Trust Fund Board of Governors.  
23 Board of Governors members shall be chosen by veteran  
24 service organizations and the Oklahoma Veterans Council.

1 The monies in the trust fund shall not be used by the  
2 Legislature to replace other state funds used to support  
3 veterans. The State Board of Equalization shall determine  
4 if any trust funds are being used to replace state funding  
5 for veterans. If funding is found to have been replaced,  
6 the Legislature shall not make any appropriations until the  
7 amount of replaced funding is returned to the trust fund.

11 SECTION 3. The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives,  
12 immediately after the passage of this resolution, shall prepare and  
13 file one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in  
14 SECTION 2 hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the  
15 Attorney General.

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
