8 AS INTRODUCED

9 A Resolution proclaiming February 17, 2026, as
10 Oklahoma Aggregates Day at the Capitol; celebrating
11 the industry's economic impact; and recognizing the
12 importance of aggregates for local infrastructure.

13 WHEREAS, Oklahoma's economy depends on quality infrastructure -
14 from highways, roads, streets, and bridges to home foundations,
15 office walls, glass for all uses, and fracking sand that powers
16 Oklahoma's oil and natural gas industry; and

17 WHEREAS, all those critical economic outcomes begin with the
18 production and use of aggregates - the rock, sand, gravel, and
19 gypsum that lays the foundation for all infrastructure; and

20 WHEREAS, aggregates in Oklahoma is a nearly \$1 billion industry,
21 supporting 8,450 jobs and \$457 million in annual employee
22 compensation, paying 20% higher-than-average Oklahoma wages; and

23 WHEREAS, Oklahoma aggregates are the primary construction
24 material used by the Department of Transportation, Oklahoma Turnpike

1 Authority, and county, city, and tribal governments, as well as real
2 estate developers and homebuilders.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
4 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

5 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives declares February 17,
6 2026, as Oklahoma Aggregates Day at the Capitol.

7 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives recognizes and
8 celebrates the impact of the aggregate industry on Oklahoma's
9 infrastructure and economy.
