11 An Act relating to the State Department of Health;  
12 making an appropriation; identifying source;  
13 providing amount; stating purpose; providing for  
14 noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 There is hereby appropriated to the State Department of Health  
19 from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue  
20 Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025,  
21 the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) or so much thereof as  
22 may be necessary to pay for legacy contracts associated with the  
23 Choosing Childbirth Program.

1       SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
