COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
Commerce; making appropriations; identifying sources;
establishing amounts; providing purposes; providing
for noncodification; providing an effective date; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund created pursuant to
Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes the sum of Five
Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
necessary to provide funding for a municipal park located in a

1 county with a population greater than seven hundred fifty thousand
2 (750,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial Census and north
3 of I-344 and west of I-35.

4 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
5 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

6 There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
7 Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
8 Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund created pursuant to
9 Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes the sum of Four
10 Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
11 necessary to relocate a naval submarine located east of State
12 Highway 165 and north of State Highway 62.

13 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
14 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

15 There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
16 Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
17 Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund created pursuant to
18 Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes the sum of One
19 Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,800,000.00) or so much
20 thereof as may be necessary to implement infrastructure improvements
21 at an industrial park located south of State Highway 62 and east of
22 State Highway 283.

23 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
