17	SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
18	Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled House Bill
19	No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the
20	sum of Ten Million Eight Hundred Twelve Thousand Four Hundred Eight
21	Dollars (\$10,812,408.00) shall be used for program growth and to
22	replace funding no longer available due to the reduction of federal
23	matching dollars.

1 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled House Bill 2 No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the 3 sum of Nine Million Four Hundred Eighty Thousand Four Hundred 4 5 Twenty-one Dollars (\$9,480,421.00) shall be used to meet the obligations required in the consent decree pursuant to case number 6 23-cv-81-GKF-JFJ filed in the United States District Court for the 7 Northern District of Oklahoma. 8

9 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Department of 10 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled House Bill 11 No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the 12 sum of Eighteen Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars 13 (\$18,500,000.00) shall be used for the continuum of care for 14 children in crisis.

SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000.00) shall be used to maintain services for veterans and their families. SECTION 5. The Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services may request through the Director of the Office of
