There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma 15 Department of Aerospace and Aeronautics from any monies not 16 17 otherwise appropriated from the Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund of the State Treasury created in Section 256 of 18 Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the sum of Fifteen Million 19 Dollars (\$15,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to 20 make needed upgrades to infrastructure on or near the grounds of a 21 primary commercial airport, categorized as a small-hub or larger, 22 centrally located in the state to maintain and enhance aerospace 23 capabilities and increase future economic development in the state.
