COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to Department of Mental Health and
Substance Abuse Services; making an appropriation;
identifying source of funds; stating purpose;
reappropriating and redesignating funds; stating
purpose; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services from any monies not
otherwise appropriated from the Statewide Recovery Fund of the State
Treasury created in Section 255 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma
Statutes, the sum of Seven Million Nine Hundred Twenty-nine Thousand
Five Hundred Ninety-six Dollars and forty-five cents (\$7,929,596.45)
or so much thereof as may be necessary to address the ongoing
increased demand for mental health services by expanding the
infrastructure of the Tulsa Center for Behavioral Health to increase

1 capacity. Such funds shall be utilized in a manner consistent with
2 the recommendations adopted by the Joint Committee on Pandemic
3 Relief Funding on May 12, 2025.

4 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION AND REDESIGNATION

5 The amount of Sixty-six Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
6 (\$66,500,000.00) of the original appropriation of Eighty-seven
7 Million Dollars (\$87,000,000.00), appropriated to the Department of
8 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services by Section 1 of Enrolled
9 House Bill No. 1013 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 58th
10 Oklahoma Legislature, from any monies not otherwise appropriated
11 from the Statewide Recovery Fund of the State Treasury created in
12 Section 255 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to address the
13 ongoing increased demand for mental health services by constructing
14 a replacement facility for Griffin Memorial Hospital, provided that
15 such construction be confined within a thirty-mile radius of the
16 State Capitol Building, is hereby reappropriated and redesignated to
17 address the ongoing increased demand for mental health services by
18 purchasing and renovating a replacement facility for Griffin
19 Memorial Hospital; provided, that such facility be confined within a
20 thirty-mile radius of the State Capitol Building and to retain a
21 third-party construction manager with experience in behavioral
22 health hospitals to assist in this project. Such funds shall be
23 utilized in a manner consistent with the recommendations adopted by
24 the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding on May 12, 2025. If,

1 on the date this act is approved, any of the amount originally
2 appropriated, as adjusted by expenditures, encumbrances and
3 transfers, results in an unencumbered balance less than the
4 reappropriated and redesignated amount, that reappropriated and
5 redesignated amount is reduced to the unencumbered amount.

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
