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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
17	Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services from any monies not
18	otherwise appropriated from the Statewide Recovery Fund of the State
19	Treasury created in Section 255 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma
20	Statutes, the sum of Seven Million Nine Hundred Twenty-nine Thousand
21	Five Hundred Ninety-six Dollars and forty-five cents (\$7,929,596.45)
22	or so much thereof as may be necessary to address the ongoing
23	increased demand for mental health services by expanding the
24	infrastructure of the Tulsa Center for Behavioral Health to increase

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capacity. Such funds shall be utilized in a manner consistent with the recommendations adopted by the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding on May 12, 2025.

SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION AND REDESIGNATION

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The amount of Sixty-six Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$66,500,000.00) of the original appropriation of Eighty-seven Million Dollars (\$87,000,000.00), appropriated to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services by Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1013 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Statewide Recovery Fund of the State Treasury created in Section 255 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to address the ongoing increased demand for mental health services by constructing a replacement facility for Griffin Memorial Hospital, provided that such construction be confined within a thirty-mile radius of the State Capitol Building, is hereby reappropriated and redesignated to address the ongoing increased demand for mental health services by purchasing and renovating a replacement facility for Griffin Memorial Hospital; provided, that such facility be confined within a thirty-mile radius of the State Capitol Building and to retain a third-party construction manager with experience in behavioral health hospitals to assist in this project. Such funds shall be utilized in a manner consistent with the recommendations adopted by the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding on May 12, 2025.

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on the date this act is approved, any of the amount originally
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    appropriated, as adjusted by expenditures, encumbrances and
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    transfers, results in an unencumbered balance less than the
    reappropriated and redesignated amount, that reappropriated and
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    redesignated amount is reduced to the unencumbered amount.
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        SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
