McCarty 15 Center for Children with Developmental Disabilities from any monies 16 not otherwise appropriated from the Statewide Recovery Fund of the 17 State Treasury created in Section 255 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma 18 Statutes, the sum of Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000.00) or 19 so much thereof as may be necessary to provide medical care for 20 children with developmental disabilities who are disproportionately 21 impacted by the pandemic. Such funds shall be utilized in a manner 22 consistent with the recommendations adopted by the Joint Committee
