10 An Act relating to J.D. McCarty Center for Children  
11 with Developmental Disabilities; making an  
12 appropriation; identifying source of funds; stating  
13 purpose; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the J.D. McCarty  
16 Center for Children with Developmental Disabilities from any monies  
17 not otherwise appropriated from the Statewide Recovery Fund of the  
18 State Treasury created in Section 255 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma  
19 Statutes, the sum of Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000.00) or  
20 so much thereof as may be necessary to provide medical care for  
21 children with developmental disabilities who are disproportionately  
22 impacted by the pandemic. Such funds shall be utilized in a manner  
23 consistent with the recommendations adopted by the Joint Committee  
24 on Pandemic Relief Funding on May 12, 2025.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
