10 An Act relating to the Office of Management and  
11 Enterprise Services; making an appropriation;  
12 identifying source of funds; stating purpose;  
providing an effective date; and declaring an  
emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of  
16 Management and Enterprise Services from monies not otherwise  
17 appropriated from the ARPA Administrative Costs Fund created in  
18 Section 255.5 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the sum of Two  
19 Million Four Hundred Eighteen Thousand One Hundred Eighty Dollars  
20 (\$2,418,180.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay for  
21 expenses arising from implementing programs and expenditures in  
22 accordance with actions taken by the Joint Committee on Pandemic  
23 Relief Funding.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

1       SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
