**Research Analysis**

The Senate Amendments to HB 1003 modifies the age limitation for rape by increasing the age of consent to 18 years of age. The measure removes an age qualifier to clarify that sex between a school employee and a student under the age of 20 is considered rape. The measure modifies the Romeo and Juliet provisions by providing that it is not considered rape if the victim is under the age of 18 unless the person was more than 4 years older than the other person at the time of the act.
