**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1036 is a sunset bill which modifies the termination date for the Oklahoma Board of Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselors, thereby granting a one-year extension from July 2025 to July 2026. The measure is merely extends the termination date for a non-appropriated agency and does not carry any fiscal or revenue considerations for the state. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
