Research Analysis

The Senate Amendments to HB 1075 modifies the procedure a school district superintendent must follow when they are filing a termination recommendation for a teacher or administrator who is under investigation for the alleged abuse or sexual abuse of a student.

The measure requires a superintendent to submit a copy of their recommendation for termination to the State Board of Education regardless of whether the staff member resigns before or after the recommendation is made. A report of such resignation, including any investigatory findings must also be sent to the State Board.

If the investigation into the staff member concludes without findings that support termination or criminal charges, the employee's report must be expunged from the State Board of Education's records.

If the school employee is working at a new district, or is under consideration for employment at a new district, and that new district requests a copy of the recommendation for termination from the State Board, the employee retains the right to provide supplementary information.
