Research Analysis

The Senate amendments to HB 1084 include a service provider in the definition of *person* and require insurers to pay a person directly when the insured agrees on direct payment.

HB1804, as amended, prohibits the solicitation or acceptance of assignment agreements for postloss insurance benefits for property damage under auto, residential, or commercial property insurance policies. The measure does not apply to assignments, transfers, pledges, or conveyances granted to federally insured financial institutions, mortgagees, or subsequent purchasers of the property as well as liability coverage under the specified insurance policies.
