**Fiscal Analysis**

The POLREC to HB1129 increases the filing fee for forcible entry and detainer from \$85 to \$100. Despite the increased cost to file, it is unknown whether or not the number of filings will decrease. Therefore, in its current form, HB1129 is anticipated to be overall budget neutral to state revenues and appropriations.
